By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,000 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake allowed 2 lbs.; of a Sweepstake allowed 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state bred allowance allowed 6 lbs.; of a race other than maiden, claiming, starter or state bred allowance allowed 8 lbs. SEEK AND DESTROY took up residence near the back of the pack after bumping lightly with EYEINTHESKY in the shadow of the starting gate, was in path three in pursuit of the front runners during the run around the bend, angled into path five for clearance spinning into the stretch, closed in ready on the one to catch, fought her way to the front end inside the sixteenth pole, edged away then dug in late to preserve the decision. FEEL GLORIOUS (GB) moved over to the rail well before arriving at the conclusion of the backstretch, drafted behind STILLWATER COVE on the turn, flashed interest when let out a notch approaching the quarter pole, continued to idle along the previously-named opponent after stepping into the lane, eagerly moved into a narrow hole in midstretch firmly cemented herself into it, traded a few bumps with STILLWATER COVE as they each fought each other for the same spot, came up the victor of that skirmish, kicked into her best, but was outfinished by the winner. MY GALINA was rated along cutting the pace from along the rail until upper stretch, got reeled in by the top one in the general area of the sixteenth pole, weakened into the show slot. STILLWATER COVE grabbed the pocket after the start, was kept on hold as the field made its way to the quarter pole, drifted into the two path when put to a drive coming up to the furlong grounds, leaving the inside corridor open fleetingly, but long enough for FEEL GLORIOUS to move up, leaned inward trying to clamp it down, came up the loser by deep stretch after exchanging contact with the aforementioned rival, then after that contact wound up backing away into the last on the board slot. MISSMIZZ stalked the pace from the two path, got turned loose for the drive home, kept up her pursuit in earnest before backing away in the final sixteenth. EYEINTHESKY came in slightly springing from the gate, was taken in hand and corrected but not before making some light contact with the eventual winner, sat in path two in midpack taking up the chase, swung into path three for entrance into the lane, made no headway. ENTIRELY poised three wide within striking distance of the leader, commenced the stretch slightly wide, failed to fire appreciably. WAVING FLAGS off the inside throughout, stepped onto the turn three wide, shifted closer to the rail coming up to the five-sixteenths pole, was under a ride heading home, had no rally. Following a Stewards' inquiry focusing on the stretch run, in addition to a claim of foul lodged by rider of STILLWATER COVE against the rider of FEEL GLORIOUS alleging interference, the result was allowed to stand and the race was declared official.
