

**7 FURLONGS. ( Turf ) ( 1.19' ) PARADISE CREEK S. Purse \$100,000 FOR THREE YEAR OLDS.**  
 By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,000 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Stakes race allowed 2 lbs.; of a Sweepstake allowed 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state bred allowance allowed 6 lbs.; of a race other than maiden, claiming, starter or state bred allowance allowed 8 lbs. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, May 11, 2019 with 27 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at Seven Furlongs on the Main Track.) (Rail at 18 feet).

POLE SETTER away without apparent mishap, established control in short order, showed the way from along the inside route, coaxed and with a well-rated MUCHO in attendance two to three wide, was put to a drive getting put to the test by the aforementioned rival in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, staved off that foe, then continued onward with much willingness to fend off PULSATE'S laterally. PULSATE unhurried taking up the chase from the two path, got fanned five wide entering the stretch, becoming the widest of all, got cued up and began to whittle away at the deficit, came in slightly after three light right handed shots in deep stretch, leading UNCAPPED to get steadied, continued on with good energy and procured the place. STRIKE SILVER was sighted pulling on the bit while racing along the inside early on the backstretch, managed to slip into the path two at the midway point of the turn, got asked for more heading home, was briefly knocked off stride when bumped into by FOG OF WAR in the general area of the three-sixteenths marker, recovered then rallied mildly alternating between the two path and the inside route the rest of the way to the finish line. MUCHO was well rated prompting the winner two to three wide, challenged in earnest upon reaching the three-sixteenths pole, got staved off, weakened late. UNCAPPED off the inside throughout, travelled about the turn two to three wide, angled into path four for the drive home, wasn't posing a threat for a top spot when put in tight and steadied in deep stretch. FOG OF WAR broke in an awkward manner, was moved into the three path, was still there departing the backstretch, swung into the stretch, lugged in, making contact with STRIKE SILVER at the three-sixteenths pole, got worked back into the three path, made no headway in the final furlong. IAN GLASS settled into the path two after springing from the starting gate, appeared unsettled wedged in between rivals during the initial stages, eventually getting checked, cut over to the inside route at the half mile pole, was still along it stepping into the stretch, steadied off the heels of another right around the three-sixteenths marker, ventured onward, steadied a third time, prior to altering course to the outside with approximately a sixteenth remaining, made it across the wire, capping off her hard-luck journey. Following a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on PULSATE in the stretch, the result was allowed to stand and the race was declared official.
