7 FURLONGS. (1.194) MIKE LEE S. Purse \$125,000 FOR THREE YEAR OLDS FOALED IN NEW YORK STATE AND APPROVED BY THE NEW YORK STATE-BRED REGISTRY. By subscription of \$125 each which should accompany the nomination. \$600 to pass the entry box and an additional \$650 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,250 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight, 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstake in 2019 allowed 2 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming or starter allowed 4 lbs.; of a race other than maiden or claiming allowed 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, May 11, 2019 with 23 Nominations.

BLINDWILLIE MCTELL away the quickest, remained forwardly placed, was rated along attending LE GENERAL from path two, turned for home on dead even terms with the aforementioned foe, struck the three-sixteenths pole and was turned loose, scampered away to what turned out to be his largest lead the rest of the trip to the eighth pole, dug in with good determination thereafter to stay in the clear. FUNNY GUY brushed from both sides in the shadow of the starting gate, was unhurried taking the two path for the opening half, flashed interest getting set down springing from the five-sixteenths marker, was angled out approximately six wide into the stretch, got engaged in a duel with BANKIT by midstretch, bested that rival to win place honors. BANKIT took up the chase two to three wide, was fanned out into path seven during the initial portion of the stretch, becoming the widest of all, began to rally in unison with the second place finisher at the furlong grounds, failed to reel in the winner then failed failed to procure the place too. JUST RIGHT lightly hand ridden tracking the pace from the pocket, was put to a drive approaching the quarter pole, worked his way into the three path between that station and the three-sixteenths pole, flattened out. LE GENERAL went to the outside after taking an awkward initial step, got corrected but not before making light contact with its next door neighbor, grabbed command and was guided over to the rail, showed the way, with a well-rated BLINDWILLIE MCTELL applying pressure from the outside, proved no match when challenged by that opponent in upper stretch and tired. DURKIN'S CALL brushed at the start, made it over to the rail soon afterwards, went on to save ground to no avail. FROSTED ICE three wide on the turn, got set down coming up to the quarter pole, backed away readily once into the stretch. FLEET WARRIOR four wide onto the turn, was one path farther off the rail exiting it, gave way.
