DR JOHN H away well and raced to a narrow advantage entering the backstretch while racing one out from the rail, set a pressured pace in the run down the backstretch and into the final turn, maintained his advantage into the stretch, and held EXPLODE safely at bay late in a game effort. EXPLODE settled off the early pace while racing three wide entering the backstretch, rallied smartly three out from the rail entering the final turn, and finished determinedly three wide in the drive to prove clearly second best. CALL IT A WRAP unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied smartly from along the inside entering the final turn, tipped four wide leaving the turn and entering the stretch, and closed with a rush to get up for a share. MORO TEXAS broke sharply and tracked the leader into the backstretch while racing two out from the rail, rallied three wide entering the final turn while pressing the leader, was unable to match strides with that foe entering the lane, and was outfinished late. SHRUGGY BEAR stalked the leaders from along the rail entering the backstretch, rallied three wide through the final turn, and closed willingly three wide from between rivals in the stretch drive. DAT DAY stalked the leaders in the run down the backstretch while racing two out from the rail, rallied three wide through the final turn, but lacked the needed closing response when called upon. RING OF KERRY stalked the early pace while racing one out from the rail entering the backstretch, rallied two wide entering the final turn, but was outfinished in the drive. STAY FANTASTIC settled off the early pace while racing two wide into the backstretch, rallied five wide entering the final turn, but failed to mount a serious late bid. BUGSY settled off the early pace while saving ground at the rail entering the backstretch, raced four wide into the final turn, but lacked the needed closing response when called upon. MCMURPHY away alertly and rushed up in tight quarters at the rail entering the first turn to vie for the early lead, chased the lead from along the rail in the run down the backstretch, but weakened over the final furlong. MOVE ON settled off the early pace while racing three out from the rail entering the backstretch, dropped back to trail in the run to the final turn, and failed to respond when called upon.
