SHE'S A JULIE got sent over to the inside after getting away in good order, was some under some hand encouragement tracking the frontrunners going at it side by side for control, was cued up turning into the lane three wide under a hard drive, found herself teamed up with POINT OF HONOR closing in on OLLIE'S CANDY, reeled in the latter nearing the wire then crossed it just in time to earn the decision. POINT OF HONOR remained in the two path after the field had been sent off and running, got put to a prolonged drive after entering the turn, spun into the lane approximately four wide, gained on the one to catch in unison with the winner, missed. OLLIE'S CANDY sparred for command lightly hand urged from path two, increased her presence during the run around the bend, grabbed the advantage late on the bend to lead the others into the stretch by a long head, had the pilot go to work, emerged the eighth pole holding her largest lead, saw the top twosome whittle away at it, eventually getting reeled in in the shadow of the finish line. BLAMED vied for the top from along the inside route, coaxed along and with OLLIE'S CANDY in attendance to her outside, came under heavier pressure from the aforementioned opponent once beyond the half mile pole, got headed as the pair approached the end of the bend, remained a prominent factor for the next furlong before backing away. PINK SANDS raced towards the inside, slipped to the outside and was asked for more at the three-eighths pole, was moved out five wide into the stretch, didn't make any headway, then finished off the final furlong having been placed to a protective hold. GOLDEN AWARD sat for war dly placed three wide until the conclusion of the backstretch, failed to respond when put to an abbreviated drive early on the turn, fell back farther and farther, stopped to a walk while being eased down the lane.
