SHE'S SO SPECIAL stalked a bit off the rail then between foes into and on the turn, rallied between rivals under strong handling and a late crack of the whip to gain the advantage in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. EL TIGRE TERRIBLE saved ground stalking the pace, awaited room inside behind horses leaving the turn then a bit off the rail to the sixteenth pole, came out off heels in deep stretch and got up for second four wide on the line. THANKS MR. EIDSON had speed three deep then stalked three wide to the stretch and continued willingly between foes late. PHANTOM BOSS went up inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the turn and through the stretch and continued willingly but was edged for a minor share late. ROOKIE MISTAKE was bumped then bobbed just after the start, stalked outside a rival then three deep into the turn, fell back some on the bend, swung four wide into the stretch and also went on willingly late. PARTY TOWN broke in and bumped a rival, dueled between horses then outside a foe, fought back between horses in the final furlong and was outfinished but shared fifth.
