1 1/8 MILES. (Inner Turf) (1.45) FORT MARCY S. Grade II.Purse \$200,000 INNER TURF FOR FOUR-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. Non-Lasix Race pursuant to 4043.2 (7)(e)(5) Lasix not permitted within 48 hours of post time. By subscription of \$200 each which should accompany the nomination. \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$2,000 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight: 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$150,000 twice at a mile or over on the turf in 2020-21 allowed 2 lbs.; of such a race in 2020-21 or two Sweepstakes at a mile or over since September 1, 2020 allowed 4 lbs.; of a Sweepstake at a mile or over in 2020-21 allowed 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, April 17, 2021 with 18 Original Nominations and 3 Supplements. (Rail at 27 feet).

TRIBHUVAN (FR) went clear early, rounded the first turn in the two to three path under restraint, opened up a sizable advantage while off the inside, remained clear while inside to the two path on the final turn, responded well when asked at the quarter-pole, came under a right-handed crop in upper stretch, kept finding more in the final furlong and prevailed under strong urging. CITY MAN dropped from the two path to the rail on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, raced inside early on the far turn then moved to the two path, was roused outside the quarter-pole, turned into upper stretch under a drive, pursued the winner under a left-handed crop into the final furlong, switched to a right-handed crop outside the sixteenth-pole and finished with good courage but was second best. ROCKEMPEROR (IRE) shifted from the rail to the two path on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer with a half-mile to run, went three then four wide on the far turn, was asked at the five-sixteenths, came five wide into the stretch, brushed with a foe around the three-sixteenths, reached a reasonable attack position into the final furlong but lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. DEVAMANI (FR) settled while saving ground, moved closer late on the backstretch, raced inside to the two path on the far turn, was roused at the five-sixteenths, turned into the stretch under the crop, held a reasonable striking position into the final furlong but flattened out and lacked the needed response. WISSAHICKON went four wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, raced three wide on the far turn, was given his cue outside the quarter-pole, spun four wide into the stretch and came up empty.
