MS CARROLL COUNTY mid pack, behind horses behind the lead flight into the lane, angled in, bid for place late, outkicked for that position. FLY LIKE THE WIND in the main group while racing off the inside, patiently handled behind traffic late in the turn, improved in upper stretch when clear then went flat late. SASSY LASS in the main body up the backstretch outside, angled five down to the two path late turn, traffic into the lane, improved inside through the lane. SUMMORYA off slowly, raced back and in the two path, improved inside of some rivals into the lane then went flat through the lane. COUNTIT ALL JOY broke alertly, narrowly showed the way up the backstretch closest to the inside, began a gradual fade after a half. DOUGHTY raced within contact of the lead pack well wide, five wide turn, failed to muster a rally. UNBEARABLE off a step slow, raced back and off the inside, angled out to be four wide by midway on the turn, lacked a closing response. LASSIE MY GIRL lacked speed well wide, six wide through the turn, failed to rally as well. BETTY JO pressured the pace from the three path for three furlongs, stopped by late in the turn.
