RED ROUTE ONE saved ground well back, launched a raily inside of foes turning for home, tipped outside of the top pair to sustain progress leaving the furlong grounds, bid entering the final sixteenth and drove clear. TOUCHUPONASTAR showed the way inside of a prompting foe, dueled with that bidder turning for home, repelled his counterpart as an outer bidder menaced nearing the final sixteenth, got bested by that one passing that marker and held place. MONEY SUPPLY settled in the two path, advanced inside of rivals into the far turn before tipping to the three path at the three furlong pole, shifted out to the five path in upper stretch and ran on to edge show late. VELOCITOR stalked along the inside, chased closest to the top pair and from the two path around the far turn, but lacked a bid while getting out kicked by a rival on either side in midstretch. BEST ACTOR prompted three to two wide around the first turn, sustained pressure before bidding and sparking a duel turning for home, but hung on his left lead and yielded between horses at the sixteenth pole. GASOLINE tracked from midpack along the inside, shifted to the four path entering the backstretch, pursued before drifting to the five path entering the lane and failed to factor. HAPPY AMERICAN turned his lead to the right just before the gates sprung and broke slow, lagged behind, moved forward along the inside turning for home, but flattened out. SUPER CORINTO (ARG) laid off of the pace in the three to five path and failed to factor. BLACK BELT stalked from the two to three path but faded into the far turn.
