A G'S CHARLOTTE tracked from midpack fourto five path, then ran on betw een hor ses. THETRUTHISTHETRUTH show ed theway in the three to two path ar ound the first turn, held sway into the turn, but was bested by an outer bidder near ing the furlong grounds and gave way. BASALT STREET tracked along the inside, then from the two path around the far turn, chased between hor ses in upper stretch and yielded. WORLD WAR raced off of the pace two wide and between horses, then along the inside around the far turn butlacked a bid. SPIRITED BEAUTY broke slowly, lacked speed two to four wide and made little impact. VISIONISTA sav ed ground off of the pace to no avail. SPEEDY DUDETTE prompted from the six to four path around the first turn, but drifted back to the six path turning for home and weakened. ALPINE MIST stuttered a step at thestart, pursued from the five to six path and tir ed early. VALE MALE prompted inthe four to three path and between horse ar ound the first turn, butweakened near ing the nine sixt eenths pole.
