AIR FORCE RED broke alertly and assumed command away from the start, set decent fractions while well handled through the backstretch run, was pressed by ASTRONOMER into the second turn then repelled that rival into upper stretch, dug in while under pressure approaching the final sixteenth, drifted out a path inside of the sixteenth-pole, met the bid of LAMMAS in deep stretch and was tagged for the win in the final strides.
