INNER TURF FOR FILLIES AND MARES FOUR-YEAR- OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$200 each which should accompany the nomination. \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$2,000 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weights 123. Non-winners of \$150,000 twice at a mile or over in 2017-18 allowed 2 lbs.; of such a race in 2017-18 or \$60,000 twice at mile or over since September 1, 2017 allowed 4 lbs.; of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2017-18 allowed 6lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state bred at a mile or over since September 1, 2017 allowed 8 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to thhe Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, April 28, 2018 with 19 Nominations. (Rail at 9 feet).

A RAVING BEAUTY (GER) bobbled lightly in the shadow of the starting gate, responded to a snug hold being applied and tucked over to the inside route early on the backstretch, kept watch on the leader under patient handling, was switched over to a stronger ride moving to the outside heading home, quickened soon afterwards, shooting her way to the top, drifted a bit right around the eighth pole but held a straighter course thereafter as she kicked clear. INFLEXIBILITY was one of two getting checked during the final stages of the run around the first turn, sat reserved in path two for the opening three-quarters, was tipped to the outside leaving the five-sixteenths pole, wound up five wide and under a drive a furlong down the road, went at it head to head with LIDO for the last eighth and gamely beat that foe for place honors. LIDO rode the rail for the opening six furlongs, picked up interest swinging out into path four heading for upper stretch, kicked into her best stride, raced abreast of INFLEXIBILITY for the final furlong, lost the place. TEAM OF TEAMS established control in short order, was coaxed along the inside on a loosely-contested lead, gave in when challenged by the winner during the runner leading up to and then through the furlong grounds and steadily backed away. TRICKY ESCAPE off to a sluggish beginning, went about the backstretch two wide pulling a bit on the bit, got angled six wide into the lane, came up empty. MY IMPRESSION checked on the opening bend, went on to save ground to no avail. BROKEN BRIDLE three wide on the first turn, attended the pacesetter closer to the rail afterwards, completed three-quarters and gave way.
