By subscription of \$300 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$3,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight, 121 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, July 7, 2018 with 17 Nominations.

MONOMOY GIRL was hustled to the lead, raced inside on the first turn, set the pace while getting some company to her outside, controlled the action in the two path on the far turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, responded well when shaken up in upper stretch and drew away while kept to the task under a solid hand ride. MIDNIGHT BISOU came away in good order, rounded the first turn in the two path, settled in third position, moved closer inside the three-quarter pole, went around the far turn in the four path, was roused at the five-sixteenths, chased the winner under the whip into the final furlong and proved no match while clear for the place. CHOCOLATE MARTINI settled on the inside, moved closer under coaxing on the far turn, was roused while cutting the corner into the stretch, chased under the whip past the three-sixteenths, dropped back into the final furlong and weakened but earned the show. ESKIMO KISSES traveled around the first turn in the three path, settled at the rear on the outside, passed the half-mile pole under urging, came under stronger encouragement in the two path early on the far turn, shifted four wide outside the quarter-pole, came five wide into the stretch under the whip and failed to respond. GIO GAME came out in front, raced in the three path on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, vied in the three path on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths, dropped back between horses into upper stretch and faded.
