

1 MILE. (1.33) BRUCE D. MEMORIAL S. Purse \$100,000 FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. Nominations closed Wednesday August 1, 2018, with no fee. A Supplementary nomination of \$1,250 may be made on Wednesday August 8, 2018, which includes entry and starting fees. Original nominees to pay \$400 to pass the entry box and an additional \$400 to start, with \$100,000 Guaranteed; after payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. WEIGHT: 122 lbs. Non Winners of \$50,000 in 2018, allowed 3 lbs.; \$35,000 once or \$20,000 twice in 2018, allowed 5 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered.) This event will be limited to (12) twelve starters. High Weights preferred. Preference of horses of equal weight will be Highest Total Earnings in 2018. Failure to draw into this race at time of entry cancels all fees. Starters to be named through the entry box at usual time of closing. Two (2) horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single ownership interest. Trophy to the owner of the winner. SIR ANTHONY broke outward, was quickly righted and chased the pace inside, edged closer from the five eighths mark, entered the turn inside behind the leading flight, breathed down their necks along the inside through the turn, came into the lane two wide after STROLLIN THE BAYOU advanced to his inside, split between NAVY ARMED GUARD and THE TABULATOR approaching the furlong pole, and kicked away. NOBRAG JUSTFACT bobbed at the break, showed some early foot between horses but settled to track the pace two wide, tracked the leading trio after CHIEF OAKIE DOKIE pulled to join the vanguard, continued three wide in a tracking flight through the bend and into the stretch, and chased three to four wide down the lane while proving no match for the winner. P R RADIO STAR came away a step slowly, settled near the rear, moved up while racing two wide in the rear flight into the turn, went to a drive near the quarter pole, swung five wide to the stretch, and rallied outside well enough to capture the show. NAVY ARMED GUARD hustled to the lead inside, vied inside when joined to his outside by THE TABULATOR and CHIEF OAKIE DOKIE, continued inside the leading flight through the turn and into the lane, but flattened inside in the final furlong. THE TABULATOR came away sharply, vied two wide when joined to his inside by NAVY ARMED GUARD, continued three wide in the leading flight when CHIEF OAKIE DOKIE joined the leading group, continued vying in the leading flight three wide through the turn and into the lane, but weakened in the final furlong. NOTTOWAY tracked four wide early, settled to chase behind the first two flights as the field approached the turn, continued patiently, came into the stretch in the three path at the rear, and offered a mild rail rally in the lane. STROLLIN THE BAYOU trailed, took closer order along the rail through the turn, rallied while saving ground into the lane, but flattened out in the final furlong. WILE E PEYOTE tracked the pace two wide, ranged into contention approaching the turn, continued between horses in the tracking flight around the bend, came three wide into the stretch, and offered no bid. CHIEF OAKIE DOKIE briefly stalked the pace inside, pulled keenly to join the leading flight near the five eighths mark, continued vying between horses through the turn, but emptied out into the lane and was eased.
