CARRICK tracked the pace on the outside running around the first turn in the three path, settled nicely on the backstretch maintaining his position, went two wide turning for home but swung four wide into the stretch, hit his best stride with a furlong to go when he locked horns with an unwavering foe, dug in gamely and prevailed. ANALYZE IT settled into position stalking the pace, went two wide around the first turn never letting the leader out of his sights, swung for home going three wide then began to edge clear in the stretch, fought back tenaciously when collared but was outgamed in the final yards. BANDUA tracked the pace while sticking to the rail the whole way, responded well when asked for more and ran gamely between horses holding on for third. PLATINUM WARRIOR (IRE) quickly got a spot on the rail and ran towards the rail in the early going, went two wide around the turn but was forced to swing into the stretch in the five path looking for running room, hit his best stride with a furlong to go but it was not enough. CAPTIVATING MOON got a spot on the rail and was allowed to settle well off the pace, maintain his position along the backstretch and went two wide turning for home, uncorked a long rally down the stretch but it was not enough. MING (IRE) bumped with PONT DU GARD at the break but quickly shook it off, was able to get a spot on the rail while running towards the rear, stayed on the inside as he turned for home but swung into the stretch in the four path, his hole closed in at the three sixteenths causing him to check, got back into stride and rerallied with a furlong to go. UNTAMED DOMAIN quickly settled into stride well rated off the pace, took both turns going three wide but had to swing five wide into the stretch and had a mild gain when asked. HUNTING HORN (IRE) was quick into stride and went up towards the front securing a spot on the rail before the turn, stalked the pace comfortably then vied for the lead at the half mile pole, turned for home going two wide keeping the pressure on but grew tired with a furlong to go. REAL STORY had a comfortable lead from the start and stayed tucked in on the inside, held sway into the stretch but gave way with a furlong to go. SNIPER KITTEN sat well rated off the pace while sticking to the inside, gained some ground on the backstretch but faded for the drive. DUBBY DUBBIE ran towards the rear while running between horses, went two wide around the turns and lacked a response when asked. LUCIUS TIBERIUS (IRE) was allowed off the pace while going three wide around the turns, lacked the needed rally. PONT DU GARD lugged out at the break and bumped with MING, ran towards the rear while in the two path then had no response when asked for more.
