TACITUS raced three wide early, settled off the pace, off the rail, moved up two wide on the far turn, raced between horses turning for home, rallied in the two path in the stretch, gained the lead near the sixteenth pole and moved clear under urging. OUTSHINE settled into stride racing well off the early pacesetters, advanced into contention on the far turn, rallied four wide into the stretch, dug in gamely in the stretch drive and closed steadily to earn the place award. WIN WIN WIN raced off the pace outside a rival, went four wide past the half mile marker, moved up three wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, rallied outside and surged late to get up for third. ZENDEN sprinted in the early stages, cleared the field, set a pressured pace, dueled with WELL DEFINED on the far turn, led into the stretch and dug in gamely through the drive to save the fourth spot. SIR WINSTON raced off the pace inside, angled out entering the stretch and closed belatedly outside. DUNPH raced off the pace outside a rival, three wide at the half mile marker, came three wide into the lane and finished evenly between horses. ADMIRE raced off the pace inside, moved up inside on the far turn, bid on the rail in the stretch and flattened out late. WELL DEFINED chased close up outside of ZENDEN through the early stages, bid on the far turn, dueled with that rival and weakened in the final furlong. THE RIGHT PATH raced three wide early, settled off the rail, off the pace, raced inside in the stretch and failed to threaten. DREAM MAKER was bumped at the start and steadied, raced off the pace, saved ground on the far turn, steadied at the quarter pole and failed to rally. LORD DRAGON bumped a rival at the start, raced off the pace inside and was outrun.
