

1 1/8 MILES. ( Turf ) ( 140' ) DIXIE S. Grade II. Purse \$250,000 FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination. \$1,200 to pass the entry box, \$1,200 to start, with \$250,000 Guaranteed (Grade I winners in the past twelve (12) months will have their entry and start fees waived if they start.), of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 6% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 1% to sixth. Supplemental nominations of \$2,500 each will be accepted by the usual time of entry with all other fees due as noted. Entry fee will be waived if horse starts. Weights: Three-Year-olds, 120 lbs.; Older 126 lbs.; Non-winners of \$150,000 at one mile or over in 2019, allowed 2 lbs.; \$100,000 at one mile or over in 2019, allowed, 4 lbs. (Maiden Claiming and Starter races not considered in estimating allowances). Trophy to the owner of the winner. Nominations Closed Tuesday, May 7, 2019 with 38 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race on the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and OneSixteenth).

CATHOLIC BOY broke inward and made some contact with INSPECTOR LYNLEY, quickly corrected and moved up to track the pace outside REAL STORY, responded when given his cue near the quarter pole, went on the attack soon into the lane, dueled under right handed pressure then gained a slim advantage a furlong out, edged away slightly in deep stretch then held firm while kept to task. ADMISSION OFFICE was bumped and squeezed back soon after the start, recovered and settled off the pace while saving ground, eased out under some coaxing into the lane, moved up past mid stretch, altered in leaving the sixteenth pole and closed gamely. JUST HOWARD was steadied off heels when a bit keen heading toward the first turn, remained inside to the head of the lane, worked his way outward through the final furlong and finished strong. REAL STORY cleared early and was nursed along towards the fence, dug in when confronted in upper stretch, spared to the inside of the winner from the three sixteenths to deep stretch then faded. O DIONYSUS, bumped and in tight at the break, recovered and edged up four wide around the first turn and into the backstretch, gained a stalking spot leaving the five eighths, ranged up to loom in mid stretch, kept on trying but wasn't quite good enough. INSPECTOR LYNLEY broke outward and brushed with the winner, corrected and moved up between foes, stalked leaving the far turn, angled out under pressure in upper stretch but went evenly in the final furlong. PHLASH PHELPS, off the pace three wide, angled eight wide in upper stretch but lacked a bid. PARET (AUS), bumped soon after the start, steadied when rank behind foes saving ground into the first turn, settled past the five eighths, had aim leaving the five sixteenths, failed to kick on in upper stretch and faded. HAVE AT IT, between runners in range past the half, gave way. SOMETHING AWESOME, two to three wide, was outrun.
