TIZANOXBOW away well, moved up to confront CRACK SHOT as the first fraction was being finalized, raced heads apart with the nemesis, pilot applying a firm grip on the reins, was turned loose as the twosome spun into the lane on near even terms, saw the ensuing furlong still having not settled the score, with both yet directly abreast at the eighth pole, slowly inched his way to the top, then edged away in the final seven yards. CRACK SHOT cut over to the inside after the start, vied with PLEBE for much of the journey leading up to the quarter pole before having that opponent get eased back, content for a pocket trip, gained no respite though, and was instead forced to go at it with the eventual winner, raced side by side with that rivals during the run around the bend, was asked for more as their tussle spilled over into the stretch, fought on with vigour before getting shaken off well inside the sixteenth marker. RINALDI had the rider bail out after acting up in the gate, settled down and was remounted, got pinched in the shadow of the starting gate, recovered and cut over to the inside, was there only fleetingly, tipping to the outside afterwards while appearing unsettled, raced two to three wide, more professionally not amongst foes any more, went slightly wider into the stretch, whittled away at the deficit, then reached the wire in time to salvage the show. DARING DISGUISE got steadied after swerving out at the start, was in path two in pursuit of the front runners, moved inward in time to cut the corner into the stretch, gained steadily, fell short of third. ADIOS AMIGOS brushed shortly after the start, travelled three to four wide on the turn, was let out springing from the five-sixteenths pole, got maneuvered into path five racing down the lane, made no headway late. PLEBE vied with the second place finisher early before getting eased back approaching the half mile pole, tracked the ongoing dispute between the first two finishers, arrived into the stretch and came up empty. BOURBON MISSION in the two path on the turn, wandered out into path seven once into the stretch, never made its presence felt. WICKED GRIN saved ground for the initial half, got sent into path six during the stretch run, lacked the needed response. APPOINTMENT brushed after the field had been released, saved ground for a good portion of the opening half, stepped into the stretch lightly hand urged, got worked into path six from upper to midstretch to no avail. FORTUNE SMILES two wide onto the turn, was sent three to four wide exiting it, gave way. BLUE PARROT was off approximately two lengths the tardiest after brushing the gate with its shoulder, departed the backstretch from the three path, came seven wide onto the head of the stretch, lugged, despite strong right side pressure and wound up trailing throughout.
