BY MY STANDARDS prompted the pace two wide and between horses, forged a lead from his inner foe turning for home, shifted to the three path to meet OWENDALE's bid, dug in gamely inside of that foe through the lane, then repelled him approaching the sixteenth pole and won going away. OWENDALE stalked the pace three wide around both turns, produced a bid for the lead turning for home while shifting to the four path, dueled outside a game BY MY STANDARDS while shifting to the five path through the lane, but was repelled by that foe approaching the sixteenth pole, then held place from an inner surging rival. SILVER DUST took up off heels into the first turn due to lack of pace, tracked the pace two wide, but came under an all out drive passing the three furlong pole, came into the lane in the four path and produced a rally between horses in the final furlong, but missed place. MCKINZIE lied close up to the pace along the inside, got keen as the leader backed down the pace into the first turn, settled into the backstretch and stalked the pace, but came under coaxing at the seven sixteenths pole, shifted to two wide in upper stretch while still inside of leading foes, attempted a bid inside of those foes at the furlong pole, but lacked a closing kick and flattened out. TITLE READY trailed the short field in the four path around the first turn, saved ground spotting the field a margin around the far turn, then produced a mild bid along the rail through the lane, lacked room passing the furlong pole, but failed to make an impact. MR FREEZE broke well and set the pace along the inside, backed down the pace into the first turn causing foes to be stacked up, held an advantage inside of the eventual winner down the backstretch and the far turn, but was headed by that foe at the quarter pole, offered little resistance and weakened.
