SITTIN ON GO raced far off of the pace behind rivals in the two path into the turn, advanced in the three to four path and outside of foes around the turn, then shifted five wide turning for home, commenced a rally in upper stretch as MIDNIGHT BOURBON kicked clear, and drove past that rival at the sixteenth pole. MIDNIGHT BOURBON stalked four to three wide, inched forward turning for home to produce a bid at the quarter pole, shifted inwards two the two path while forging an advantage in upper stretch, quickly drew clear approaching the furlong pole, but was run down by the winner at the sixteenth pole, and proved second best. SUPER STOCK lied close to the pace two wide and between horses early on, chased around the turn before shifting to the four path in upper stretch, then stayed on for a minor share. THERIDE OF A LIFETIME set the pace along the inside, held an advantage around the turn, but was headed at the three sixteenths pole, and subsequently yielded. PICO D'ORO stalked the pace along the inside, but failed to keep pace while under a drive at the five sixteenths pole, then stayed on mildly after shifting two wide, and passed tired foes in the lane. NOTARY prompted the pace three to two wide around the turn, vied turning for home, but failed to keep pace with foes on both sides passing the quarter pole, and tired. ULTIMATE BADGER tracked from midpack three wide, but came under a drive at the half mile pole, lacked a response to produce a rally, and failed to factor. CRAZY SHOT raced far off of the pace in the four path around the turn, and never got involved. DROP ANCHOR trailed the field in the three path into the turn, then shifted to the six path in midstretch while failing to make an impact. BELAFONTE tracked from midpack along the inside, but weakened passing the three furlong pole, and was done early.
