Purse \$75,000 (plus \$22,500 CBOIF – California Bred Owner Fund) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS, NON-WINNERS OF A SWEEPSTAKES OF \$60,000* OTHER THAN STATE BRED AT ONE MILE OR OVER SINCE APRIL 1. Free nominations close Thursday, October 22, 2020 with 21 or by supplementary nomination of \$750 by the closing time of entries, \$100 topass the entry box and an additional \$300 to start, with \$75,000 Added. The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to first, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth and 2% to fifth. 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 twice other than maiden or claiming at one mile or over since August 1 allowed 2 lbs.; of such a race since March 1 allowed 4 lbs. High weights preferred. Preference of horses with equal weights will be determined by 2020 non-claiming earnings. STARTERS TO BE NAMED THROUGH THE ENTRY BOX THURSDAY, OCTOBER 29, BY THE CLOSING TIME OF ENTRIES. *\$60,000 to the winner.

STRONGCONSTITUTION stalked near the inside, waited for room leaving the far turn, angled to the rail at the top of the lane, slipped through along the inside, gained command near the sixteenth pole and held over the runner-up. HEYWOODS BEACH traveled along the inside early, swung four wide into the stretch, angled further out in the lane, surged late and missed. LANE WAY tucked inside on the first turn, moved a bit off the rail on the backstretch, went three wide into the lane, asked at the eighth pole, bid between rivals and got outkicked by the top pair. I'M LEAVING YOU stumbled and bumped from both sides at the start, settled off the pace, entered the far turn three wide then angled out into the five path, took over past the eighth pole then flattened out in the final sixteenth. LURE HIM IN bumped leaving the gate, trailed the field early, angled six wide into the stretch, summoned a mild rally and improved position. GOALIE tracked from inside then taken off the rail on the backstretch, outside a rival on the second turn and got floated out by that rival entering the stretch, and failed to find the needed rally. ROOKIE MISTAKE stalked outside a rival, bid thee deep at the quarter pole, took the lead in upper stretch, in a bit tight at the sixteenth pole and weakened late. MARGOT'S BOY bumped both sides at the start, in range early off the rail, lost path at the sixteenth pole and steadied and could not regain momentum. DOMINANT SOUL broke out and bumped rival at the start, sped to the front and set a pressured pace, vied for the lead from inside leaving the turn, lost command and faded through the final furlong. JAMMERSJUSTICE pressed the pace from outside, challenge at the five-sixteenths pole, vied between rivals into the lane, bumped by rival at the eighth pole then checked mid-stretch and weakened.
