1/8 MILES. ( 1.45<sup>2</sup> ) PETER PAN S. Grade III. Purse \$200,000 FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. Non-Lasix Race pursuant to 4043.2 (7)(e)(5) Lasix not permitted within 48 hours of post time. By subscription of \$200 each which should accompany the nominations; \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$1,000 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. For original Triple Crown Nominees NYRA will waive the entry and starting fees to the Belmont Stakes for the first two finishers of the Peter Pan. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$90,000 at a mile or over in 2022 allowed 3 lbs.; of a Sweepstake other than state-bred at a mile or over or two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance allowed 5 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, April 30, 2022 with 29 Original Nominations and 1 Supplement.

WE THE PEOPLE coaxed from the gate, showed the way in hand just off the inside through moderate splits settled into a comfortable rhythm down the backstretch, tucked inside with nine-sixteenths to go and remained patiently handled through the turn, spun just off the inside into upper stretch roused for the drive went clear under a drive to the finish getting geared down inside the final seventy yards to prevail comfortably on the wire. GOLDEN GLIDER coaxed from the gate, chased three then two wide from mid pack, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while running on to just get up for the place honors on the line. ELECTABILITY coaxed from the start, chased four paths off the inside down the backstretch in closest aim of the leader, tucked to the two path through the turn coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the winner while running on to the finish and was just bested for the place honors. WESTERN RIVER stumbled at the start getting away last, came under light brief coaxing and chased five to six paths off the inside from near the rear of the field, tucked four wide through the turn and came under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled five wide into upper stretch and ran on with good courage to be along for the last major share. COOKE CREEK five paths off the inside just off the pace down the backstretch, tucked three wide through the turn coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung four wide into upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. SET SAIL coaxed from the start, chased along the inside under coaxing from three furlongs out, continued in the inside route into upper stretch and tired. COMPLETE AGENDA struck the right side stall at the start and was taken in hand, chased three then two wide under coaxing from the seven-sixteenths, angled out five wide into upper stretch and made no impact. STATE PLANNING coaxed from the gate, raced seven paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked four wide through the turn and went five wide into upper stretch, faltered and was eased to the finish.
