1 1/4 MILES. (Inner Turf) (1.573) BELMONT OAKS INVITATIONAL S. Grade I. Purse \$700,000 INNER TURF AN INVITATIONAL FOR NORTHERN HEMISPHERE, AND SOUTHERN HEMISPHERE FILLIES THREE-YEARS-OLD FOALD AFTER AUGUST 1, 2018 AND BEFORE JULY 31, 2019. Non-Lasix Race pursuant to 4043.2 (7)(e)(5) Lasix not permitted within 48 hours of post time. NYRA has entered into an agreement with Berlin-Hoppegarten Race Course in Germany for the winner of the Group Two Diana Trial to receive an automatic invitation to the Belmont Oaks (No Fees Charged). A pre-entry payment of \$5,250 (USD) by Wednesday, June 29th. An entry fee of \$5,250 (USD) will be due at time of entry. The purse for the Belmont Oaks Invitational shall be divided as follows: \$375,000 to the owner of the winner, \$130,000 to second, \$70,000 to third, \$46,000 to fourth, \$30,000 to fifth, \$20,000 to sixth, \$16,000 to seventh and \$13,000 to eighth. Weights: Northern Hemisphere, 121 lbs. Southern Hemisphere*, 125 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey.

MCKULICK (GB) tracked along the inside from mid pack, tipped to the two path into the far turn and came under coaxing advancing on the front nearing the quarter pole, swung four wide into upper stretch, rallied to engage the leader inside the eighth pole to take command just outside the sixteenth pole, then edged clear to the finish to prevail. WITH THE MOONLIGHT (IRE) coaxed from the start, tracked the leader in closest aim just off the inside, remained patiently handled until placed to coaxing five-sixteenths from home, swung three wide into upper stretch, seized command straightened away, dug in under a threat from a lone challenger and was caught a sixteenth from home, then ran on willingly to the finish to preserve the place honors by a bob of the head on the line. CONSUMER SPENDING saved ground in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, angled out four wide into upper stretch, closed well outside to miss for the place honors in the final jumps. CONCERT HALL (IRE) just off the inside in pursuit from mid pack, tipped three wide at the three-eighths placed to coaxing, angled four to five wide into upper stretch and kicked on belatedly for the last major share. CAIRO MEMORIES coaxed from the gate, showed the way lightly coaxed along the inside, had WITH THE MOONLIGHT advance outside and increase the pressure through the far turn and got placed to urging in response with five-sixteenths remaining, took the inside route into upper stretch under challenge and got collared straightened away, dug in in contention to the sixteenth marker, then weakened in the late stages. HOT QUEEN (FR) saved ground near the rear of the field, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and passed tired rivals. KNOW THYSELF (IRE) settled unhurried just off the inside near the rear of the field, remained on hold until tipped three to four wide three furlongs from home, cornered four wide into upper stretch and offered no response. NEW YEAR'S EVE two to three wide in pursuit, tipped four to five wide three furlongs from home placed to urging, went six wide into upper stretch and had no kick. HAUGHTY just off the inside just off the pace, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, cornered just off the inside for home and came up empty. AGARTHA (IRE) coaxed from the gate, tracked the pace along the inside in range of the front, got coaxed along at the three-eighths, cut the corner into upper stretch and weakened. Please note, due to an operator error, all the splits and final time provided are hand timed. The one mile split was omitted pending review.
