SHE FEELS PRETTY bobbed crossing onto the dirt then bumped between rivals shortly after, settled in a stalking position in the two path, angled out early on the far turn to launch a bid, surged to the front at the quarter pole, kicked clear while angling into the two path leaving the bend, drew away under strong handling in upper stretch, was tapped right handed past the eighth pole and ridden out to the wire. KATHYNMARISSA brushed by inner rival leaving the gate, unhurried after and moved inside, moved off the fence first time in the stretch, move up quickly five wide in the middle stages and drew alongside the top pair leaving the backstretch, lost touch with the leaders past the five-sixteenths pole, roused with a quarter mile remaining, finished willingly down the lane and proved second best. MEDORO broke out and brushed KATHYNMARISSA, bumped with outer rival while in tight next to the rail leaving the dirt crossing, was taken back off the pace, drew closer in the two path on the far turn but found traffic at the quarter pole, roused once in the clear in upper stretch and finished evenly late for the show honors. RASHMI reserved in the early going and angled to the inside at the back, trailed to the far turn, advanced two then three wide, tipped out entering the lane and summoned a mild rally to earn a minor award. WATCHTOWER got bumped between rivals early, stalked from inside, two wide around the clubhouse turn, chased three then four wide around the far turn and weakened. STRUTTING (GB) broke well then raced keenly in hand when rated, dropped back off the pace, tugged the rider along on the backstretch then moved up quickly past the half-mile pole, saved ground around the far turn, lacked room into the lane, altered out in upper stretch and could not rally after. VALENCE raced up close while widest crossing over the dirt, went up to challenge for the lead first time through the stretch, dueled around the clubhouse turn, cleared inner rival early on the backstretch, took pressure at the half-mile pole, lost command with three furlongs remaining, fought back to the quarter pole, chased the new leader in the two path turning for home and tired down the lane. CHATALAS broke well and led entering the stretch for the first time, ceded command to VIBEZ and stalked along the inside, fell out of range early on the backstretch, drew closer nearing the far turn, checked off heels at the three-eighths pole, checked in tight between rivals near the five-sixteenths pole and could not rally after. MIZZYAAN showed keen early foot under a hold, settled in a stalking position three deep, continued outside rivals into the far turn, got floated out by the winner past the three-eighths pole, spun four wide into the lane and faded. VIBEZ bumped with inner rival entering the stretch for the first time, fought for the lead outside a rival then cleared inner foe and move inside, dueled into and around the clubhouse turn, lost command early on the backstretch, went up to challenge for the lead again from inside, regained command at the three-eighths pole, fought inside rivals on the far turn, was overtaken at the quarter pole and gave way down the lane.
