

1 1/2 MILES. (Turf) (2.231) 4TH RUNNING OF THE RIVER MEMORIES. Purse \$100,000. For FILLIES AND MARES FOUR-YEAR- OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,000 (alongwith the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The guaranteed purse of \$100,000 will be divided accordingly, \$60,000 to the owner of the winner, \$20,000 to second, \$10,000 to third, \$5,000 to fourth, \$3,000 to fifth with the remaining \$2,000 divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 twice at a mile or over in 2017-18 allowed 2 lbs.; of such a race in 2017-18, 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming or starter at a mile or over in 2018, 6 lbs.; of such a race in 2018, 8 lbs. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. Closed Saturday, June 23, 2018 with 16 Original Nominations and 1 Supplement. (If the Stewards consider it in advisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile and One Eighth on the main track.) (Rail at 9 feet).

HOMELAND SECURITY made it over to the inside route well before completing the long straightaway leading up to the clubhouse turn, gained the pocket at the half mile pole, courtesy of FLOWER FASHION abandoning it to take up chase himself in path two during the run around the far turn, managed to slip to the outside coming up to the quarter pole, settled in upper stretch before issuing a three wide challenge at the three-sixteenths pole, forged to the front end a furlong down the road and edged away. SAVANNAH BELLE strung out two to three wide on the first turn, responded when let out a notch, middle-moving to the top as the pace was being backed down significantly, glided over to the inside, showed the way from that juncture until the near the end of the far turn loosely-pressed, got pounced upon by the winner in the general area of the three-sixteenths pole, put up a fight before getting collared with approximately a sixteenth remaining, then held sway for the place. SUMMERSAULT remained along the rail after the field had been sent off and running, was angled out for the final furlong, got staved off and had to settle for third. VIOLET BLUE three wide on both turns, lacked the necessary stretch response. ESTRECHADA (ARG) took up the chase in path two, undertaking the task from between opponents on the second bend, came into the stretch and was outfinished. SILVER STEP (FR) dove into the two path after the start, sat at the back of the pack, was fanned out from upper to midlane until six wide, made no impact. FLOWER FASHION (FR) out-broke the competition and retained the advantage, was firmly rated showing the way from the rail in the early going, got overpowered by the second place finisher slowing things quite a bit after completing the opening quarter, vacated the pocket to pursue the leader from path two on the turn two, spun from between rivals into lane, now more in path three than before, was taken in hand at the furlong grounds, having lost position when unable to keep pace with several others, ventured onward to the end under a light drive. NOT TAKEN stalked the pace two wide during the initial stages and gave way.
