MEASURED TIME (GB) strode to the front while in hand early, gave up the advantage into the first turn, raced in the three path on that bend, stalked the pace on the outside, took the lead before the three-eighths pole, shook clear in the two path on the far turn, came out four wide into upper stretch, responded well into the final furlong and proved best under steady urging. NATIONS PRIDE (IRE) climbed off heels briefly while taken in hand early, went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer with five furlongs to run, was roused four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, pursued the winner in the drive and finished with good courage to just get the place. OHANA HONOR saved ground on the first turn, was rated off the pace, came under urging in the two path on the far turn, spun three wide into the stretch, chased into the final furlong, moved in near the sixteenth pole and finished willingly to just miss the place while able to get a share of the show. FAR BRIDGE was hustled from the gate then taken in hand, traveled around the first turn in the three path, was reserved off the pace, brushed with a foe late on the backstretch, moved closer in the two path on the far turn, was given his cue at the quarter-pole, chased the winner in the stretch and just missed the place while able to get a share of third. PROGRAM TRADING (GB) was taken in hand early, raced in the three path on the first turn, was rated off the pace, stalked the leader in the three path on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, chased in the stretch and just missed the superfecta. AL RIFFA (FR) was hustled from the gate, went around the opening bend in the two path, settled off the pace, brushed with a foe under urging late on the backstretch, went three then four wide on the far turn, spun five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed kick. I'M VERY BUSY had his head-turned at the start and was last to commence, moved out early, rounded the first turn in the two path, dropped to the rear near the nine-sixteenths, saved ground for most of the far turn then shifted three wide, was roused four wide into the stretch, moved out near the sixteenth pole then brushed with a foe and lacked the needed response. STRONG QUALITY took the lead into the first turn, went around that bend in the two path, showed the way with company to his outside, lost the lead before the three-eighths pole, dropped back along the hedge on the far turn and gave way.
