MARLEY'S FREEDOM along the inside during the opening phases, tipped into path two as the first fraction was being posted on the board, inched up to apply pressure on BROWSE, going about it from between opponents, poked a head down in front shortly after the run leading up to the midway point of the turn was completed, turned into the stretch on practically dead even terms with the second place finisher, was in the general area of the three-sixteenths marker before having the rider go to work, went at it directly side by side against COME DANCING the rest of the home, dug in with gameness refusing to lose. COME DANCING well off the inside throughout, began to issue from path three, as the widest of three, coming up to the half mile pole, moved in tandem with the winner past the pacesetter leaving the three-eighths pole, spun into the stretch abreast of the top one, was put to a drive right about the same time and spot as MARLEY'S FREEDOM was, that is at the three-sixteenths pole, vied with vigour, at times with little if any space separating them, was game to the end but had to settle for being second best. PACIFIC WIND away well, drafted behind the runner up travelling around the far turn, was angled into path five for the drive home, straightened away and proved no match. BONITA BIANCA cut over to the inside route after the start, was let out a notch at the half mile pole, was sent to the outside after reaching the end of the bend, wandered out into path five then went on to improve position. YOUR LOVE a half length the slowest at the start, took up the chase from path two, got set to a brisk hand ride by the three-eighths pole, shifted into path four after entering the stretch, lacked a closing punch. BROWSE was taken hold after losing her footing at the start, showed no ill effects and moved up to the front end using her own power, came under pressure from the first two finishers by the crown of the turn, relinquished in the shadow of the three-eighths pole, hung around a little while longer after being set down, then backed away steadily. Following a review by NYRA in conjunction with teletimer due to the starting beam being blocked by an auxiliary gate, the race times were corrected.
